Rules & Regulations

The children are to abide by the rules and regulations of the school as stated below.

1. The School gate will remain open 15 minutes before the school morning assembly. No student will be allowed to enter the school campus after the school assembly unless a satisfactory explanation is given. It is compulsory to attend the school morning assembly.
2. Parents should collect their children within half an hour from the time the school gets over. In special cases the matter may be informed to the school authority before hand.
3. Payment of fees - Quarterly to be paid in Bank (Information will be given from school office in due time). If fees of two quarters are not paid, name may be struck off from register. In that case new admission will have to be taken.
4. Children should come every day in full school uniform (See Dress Code). In all occasions like Saraswati Puja, Annual Function children should enter school premises only in school dress.
5. An Identity Card will be issued which must be compulsorily worn by the children inside the school campus.
6. Students should bring school diary everyday. Page provided for students detail in the diary must be filled up by the parents.
7. Books can be covered either brown or transparent paper, **but note books must be covered with only transparent paper.** Parents should see to it that students maintain their books, notebooks properly throughout the year. Students should bring their books, notebooks regularly according to the table.
8. No child is allowed to go out of the gate within the school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
9. Attendance : Above 90%
10. Class Test and Project will not be conducted again in the case of absentee children.
11. No Half-Holiday will be granted except on medical ground.
12. Students should not bring any valuable articles or cash to school. In case of any loss or damage the school authority cannot be held responsible.

13. In case of absence of students from the school, parents must apply for grant of leave in the space provided in school diary or in a separate application and should give in an envelope.
14. Parents should inform the school authority before hand if any particular disease that the child suffers from regularly or at periodical intervals so that necessary precaution can be taken.
15. In case of sudden illness of any student during the school hours, the guardian will be informed first at the immediately available address and the student will be handed over to the guardians/parents of their authorized representative. In some cases if it is considered to be too late to contact the parents or guardians, the school authority may take necessary steps for medical treatment.
16. Mobile phones, pagers, motorbikes etc. are not allowed inside the school campus.
17. Parents should send the following food menu as Tiffin Mon to Sat : Roti/Puri/Luchi/ Sabji/Bread-Butter/Jam/Sandwich/Veg Pulao/Suji (Tiffin according to choice, one seasonal fruit everyday)
18. Non. Veg Tiffin is not allowed in school campus.
19. Chewing gum, Pan masala etc. is totally prohibited. If any student is found exercising these habits inside school campus strict disciplinary action will be taken against such student.
20. Parents must be in close contact with the respective class teacher for discussion on the progress of the students in their studies. In this connection they can meet the teachers on every Fourth Saturday (9.30 am to 11.30 am)
21. All parents/guardians must make themselves present in the school if and when the school authority wants.
22. The progress of the students will be closely monitored through comprehensive and continuous evaluation by the class teacher. Promotion of the child to the next higher class will be based on the class performance and overall progress of the student.
23. Students are to maintain total discipline within school campus. Necessary disciplinary action will be taken against any child who does not abide by the rules by serving notice

Rules & Regulations

The children are to abide by the rules and regulations of the school as stated below.

1. The School gate will remain open 15 minutes before the school morning assembly. No student will be allowed to enter the school campus after the school assembly unless a satisfactory explanation is given. It is compulsory to attend the school morning assembly.
2. Parents should collect their children within half an hour from the time the school gets over. In special cases the matter may be informed to the school authority before hand.
3. Payment of fees - Quarterly to be paid in Bank (Information will be given from school office in due time). If fees of two quarters are not paid, name may be struck off from register. In that case new admission will have to be taken.
4. Children should come every day in full school uniform (See Dress Code). In all occasions like Saraswati Puja, Annual Function children should enter school premises only in school dress.
5. An Identity Card will be issued which must be compulsorily worn by the children inside the school campus.
6. Students should bring school diary everyday. Page provided for students detail in the diary must be filled up by the parents.
7. Books can be covered either brown or transparent paper, **but note books must be covered with only transparent paper.** Parents should see to it that students maintain their books, notebooks properly throughout the year. Students should bring their books, notebooks regularly according to the table.
8. No child is allowed to go out of the gate within the school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
9. Attendance : Above 90%
10. Class Test and Project will not be conducted again in the case of absentee children.
11. No Half-Holiday will be granted except on medical ground.
12. Students should not bring any valuable articles or cash to school. In case of any loss or damage the school authority cannot be held responsible.

13. In case of absence of students from the school, parents must apply for grant of leave in the space provided in school diary or in a separate application and should give in an envelope.
14. Parents should inform the school authority before hand if any particular disease that the child suffers from regularly or at periodical intervals so that necessary precaution can be taken.
15. In case of sudden illness of any student during the school hours, the guardian will be informed first at the immediately available address and the student will be handed over to the guardians/parents of their authorized representative. In some cases if it is considered to be too late to contact the parents or guardians, the school authority may take necessary steps for medical treatment.
16. Mobile phones, pagers, motorbikes etc. are not allowed inside the school campus.
17. Parents should send the following food menu as Tiffin Mon to Sat : Roti/Puri/Luchi/ Sabji/Bread-Butter/Jam/Sandwich/Veg Pulao/Suji (Tiffin according to choice, one seasonal fruit everyday)
18. Non. Veg Tiffin is not allowed in school campus.
19. Chewing gum, Pan masala etc. is totally prohibited. If any student is found exercising these habits inside school campus strict disciplinary action will be taken against such student.
20. Parents must be in close contact with the respective class teacher for discussion on the progress of the students in their studies. In this connection they can meet the teachers on every Fourth Saturday (9.30 am to 11.30 am)
21. All parents/guardians must make themselves present in the school if and when the school authority wants.
22. The progress of the students will be closely monitored through comprehensive and continuous evaluation by the class teacher. Promotion of the child to the next higher class will be based on the class performance and overall progress of the student.
23. Students are to maintain total discipline within school campus. Necessary disciplinary action will be taken against any child who does not abide by the rules by serving notice

Rules & Regulations

The children are to abide by the rules and regulations of the school as stated below.

1. The School gate will remain open 15 minutes before the school morning assembly. No student will be allowed to enter the school campus after the school assembly unless a satisfactory explanation is given. It is compulsory to attend the school morning assembly.
2. Parents should collect their children within half an hour from the time the school gets over. In special cases the matter may be informed to the school authority before hand.
3. Payment of fees - Quarterly to be paid in Bank (Information will be given from school office in due time). If fees of two quarters are not paid, name may be struck off from register. In that case new admission will have to be taken.
4. Children should come every day in full school uniform (See Dress Code). In all occasions like Saraswati Puja, Annual Function children should enter school premises only in school dress.
5. An Identity Card will be issued which must be compulsorily worn by the children inside the school campus.
6. Students should bring school diary everyday. Page provided for students detail in the diary must be filled up by the parents.
7. Books can be covered either brown or transparent paper, **but note books must be covered with only transparent paper.** Parents should see to it that students maintain their books, notebooks properly throughout the year. Students should bring their books, notebooks regularly according to the table.
8. No child is allowed to go out of the gate within the school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
9. Attendance : Above 90%
10. Class Test and Project will not be conducted again in the case of absentee children.
11. No Half-Holiday will be granted except on medical ground.
12. Students should not bring any valuable articles or cash to school. In case of any loss or damage the school authority cannot be held responsible.

13. In case of absence of students from the school, parents must apply for grant of leave in the space provided in school diary or in a separate application and should give in an envelope.
14. Parents should inform the school authority before hand if any particular disease that the child suffers from regularly or at periodical intervals so that necessary precaution can be taken.
15. In case of sudden illness of any student during the school hours, the guardian will be informed first at the immediately available address and the student will be handed over to the guardians/parents of their authorized representative. In some cases if it is considered to be too late to contact the parents or guardians, the school authority may take necessary steps for medical treatment.
16. Mobile phones, pagers, motorbikes etc. are not allowed inside the school campus.
17. Parents should send the following food menu as Tiffin Mon to Sat : Roti/Puri/Luchi/ Sabji/Bread-Butter/Jam/Sandwich/Veg Pulao/Suji (Tiffin according to choice, one seasonal fruit everyday)
18. Non. Veg Tiffin is not allowed in school campus.
19. Chewing gum, Pan masala etc. is totally prohibited. If any student is found exercising these habits inside school campus strict disciplinary action will be taken against such student.
20. Parents must be in close contact with the respective class teacher for discussion on the progress of the students in their studies. In this connection they can meet the teachers on every Fourth Saturday (9.30 am to 11.30 am)
21. All parents/guardians must make themselves present in the school if and when the school authority wants.
22. The progress of the students will be closely monitored through comprehensive and continuous evaluation by the class teacher. Promotion of the child to the next higher class will be based on the class performance and overall progress of the student.
23. Students are to maintain total discipline within school campus. Necessary disciplinary action will be taken against any child who does not abide by the rules by serving notice

Rules & Regulations

The children are to abide by the rules and regulations of the school as stated below.

1. The School gate will remain open 15 minutes before the school morning assembly. No student will be allowed to enter the school campus after the school assembly unless a satisfactory explanation is given. It is compulsory to attend the school morning assembly.
2. Parents should collect their children within half an hour from the time the school gets over. In special cases the matter may be informed to the school authority before hand.
3. Payment of fees - Quarterly to be paid in Bank (Information will be given from school office in due time). If fees of two quarters are not paid, name may be struck off from register. In that case new admission will have to be taken.
4. Children should come every day in full school uniform (See Dress Code). In all occasions like Saraswati Puja, Annual Function children should enter school premises only in school dress.
5. An Identity Card will be issued which must be compulsorily worn by the children inside the school campus.
6. Students should bring school diary everyday. Page provided for students detail in the diary must be filled up by the parents.
7. Books can be covered either brown or transparent paper, **but note books must be covered with only transparent paper.** Parents should see to it that students maintain their books, notebooks properly throughout the year. Students should bring their books, notebooks regularly according to the table.
8. No child is allowed to go out of the gate within the school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
9. Attendance : Above 90%
10. Class Test and Project will not be conducted again in the case of absentee children.
11. No Half-Holiday will be granted except on medical ground.
12. Students should not bring any valuable articles or cash to school. In case of any loss or damage the school authority cannot be held responsible.

13. In case of absence of students from the school, parents must apply for grant of leave in the space provided in school diary or in a separate application and should give in an envelope.
14. Parents should inform the school authority before hand if any particular disease that the child suffers from regularly or at periodical intervals so that necessary precaution can be taken.
15. In case of sudden illness of any student during the school hours, the guardian will be informed first at the immediately available address and the student will be handed over to the guardians/parents of their authorized representative. In some cases if it is considered to be too late to contact the parents or guardians, the school authority may take necessary steps for medical treatment.
16. Mobile phones, pagers, motorbikes etc. are not allowed inside the school campus.
17. Parents should send the following food menu as Tiffin Mon to Sat : Roti/Puri/Luchi/ Sabji/Bread-Butter/Jam/Sandwich/Veg Pulao/Suji (Tiffin according to choice, one seasonal fruit everyday)
18. Non. Veg Tiffin is not allowed in school campus.
19. Chewing gum, Pan masala etc. is totally prohibited. If any student is found exercising these habits inside school campus strict disciplinary action will be taken against such student.
20. Parents must be in close contact with the respective class teacher for discussion on the progress of the students in their studies. In this connection they can meet the teachers on every Fourth Saturday (9.30 am to 11.30 am)
21. All parents/guardians must make themselves present in the school if and when the school authority wants.
22. The progress of the students will be closely monitored through comprehensive and continuous evaluation by the class teacher. Promotion of the child to the next higher class will be based on the class performance and overall progress of the student.
23. Students are to maintain total discipline within school campus. Necessary disciplinary action will be taken against any child who does not abide by the rules by serving notice

Rules & Regulations

The children are to abide by the rules and regulations of the school as stated below.

1. The School gate will remain open 15 minutes before the school morning assembly. No student will be allowed to enter the school campus after the school assembly unless a satisfactory explanation is given. It is compulsory to attend the school morning assembly.
2. Parents should collect their children within half an hour from the time the school gets over. In special cases the matter may be informed to the school authority before hand.
3. Payment of fees - Quarterly to be paid in Bank (Information will be given from school office in due time). If fees of two quarters are not paid, name may be struck off from register. In that case new admission will have to be taken.
4. Children should come every day in full school uniform (See Dress Code). In all occasions like Saraswati Puja, Annual Function children should enter school premises only in school dress.
5. An Identity Card will be issued which must be compulsorily worn by the children inside the school campus.
6. Students should bring school diary everyday. Page provided for students detail in the diary must be filled up by the parents.
7. Books can be covered either brown or transparent paper, **but note books must be covered with only transparent paper.** Parents should see to it that students maintain their books, notebooks properly throughout the year. Students should bring their books, notebooks regularly according to the table.
8. No child is allowed to go out of the gate within the school hours without prior permission of the Principal.
9. Attendance : Above 90%
10. Class Test and Project will not be conducted again in the case of absentee children.
11. No Half-Holiday will be granted except on medical ground.
12. Students should not bring any valuable articles or cash to school. In case of any loss or damage the school authority cannot be held responsible.

13. In case of absence of students from the school, parents must apply for grant of leave in the space provided in school diary or in a separate application and should give in an envelope.
14. Parents should inform the school authority before hand if any particular disease that the child suffers from regularly or at periodical intervals so that necessary precaution can be taken.
15. In case of sudden illness of any student during the school hours, the guardian will be informed first at the immediately available address and the student will be handed over to the guardians/parents of their authorized representative. In some cases if it is considered to be too late to contact the parents or guardians, the school authority may take necessary steps for medical treatment.
16. Mobile phones, pagers, motorbikes etc. are not allowed inside the school campus.
17. Parents should send the following food menu as Tiffin Mon to Sat : Roti/Puri/Luchi/ Sabji/Bread-Butter/Jam/Sandwich/Veg Pulao/Suji (Tiffin according to choice, one seasonal fruit everyday)
18. Non. Veg Tiffin is not allowed in school campus.
19. Chewing gum, Pan masala etc. is totally prohibited. If any student is found exercising these habits inside school campus strict disciplinary action will be taken against such student.
20. Parents must be in close contact with the respective class teacher for discussion on the progress of the students in their studies. In this connection they can meet the teachers on every Fourth Saturday (9.30 am to 11.30 am)
21. All parents/guardians must make themselves present in the school if and when the school authority wants.
22. The progress of the students will be closely monitored through comprehensive and continuous evaluation by the class teacher. Promotion of the child to the next higher class will be based on the class performance and overall progress of the student.
23. Students are to maintain total discipline within school campus. Necessary disciplinary action will be taken against any child who does not abide by the rules by serving notice
